## OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 17-249 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 17-217)

WHEREAS, the State Attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 17-217 to the First Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Susan Elizabeth Schiller for driving under the influence; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable WILLIAM EDDINS, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that Susan Elizabeth Schiller has been arrested for driving under the influence, violation of driver license restrictions, and driving while license suspended; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable GLENN HESS, State Attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charges in these matters; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 17-217 is hereby amended to include the additional charges of driving under the influence, violation of driver license restrictions, and driving while license suspended.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 17-217 is ratified and reaffirmed.
