## OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 17-321 (Amending Executive Order 17-313)

WHEREAS, on November 29, 2017, Executive Order 17-313 was issued extending Executive Order 16-16, extended by Executive Order 16-286, assigning the Honorable WILLIAM P. CERVONE, State Attorney for the Eighth Circuit, to the Fourth Judicial Circuit to represent the State of Florida concerning charges pending against Thomas Frank Clark; and

WHEREAS, a scrivener's error occurred advising the period of the executive assignment would be for one year, to and including January 22, 2018, when the correct date is January 22, 2019; and the state attorney shall notify this office on or before December 22, 2017, if additional time is required, and the correct date is December 22, 2018;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:


### Section 1.

Executive Order 17-313 is amended to reflect that the period of the executive assignment is for one year, to and including January 22, 2019, and the assigned state attorney shall notify the Governor on or before December 22, 2018, if additional time is required.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 17-313 is ratified and reaffirmed.
