## STATE OF FLORIDA OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 17-322

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2017, Executive Order 17-313 was issued assigning the Honorable ED BRODSKY, State Attorney for the Twelfth Judicial Circuit of Florida, to the Twentieth Judicial Circuit to handle a case pending against Lewis Swett; and

WHEREAS, a scrivener's error occurred in that a previous executive order was assigned as Executive Order 17-313, and as a result Executive Order 17-313 referencing Lewis Swett is being assigned a new number;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue the following Executive Order effective immediately: Section 1.

Executive Order 17-313, assigning the State Attorney for the Twelfth Judicial Circuit to the Twentieth Judicial Circuit regarding the case of Lewis Swett, is amended to reflect a new Executive Order Number of 17-322.

## Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 17-313, in reference to the assignment of the State Attorney for the Twelfth Judicial Circuit to the 20<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit regarding the case of Lewis Swett, is ratified and reaffirmed and is now referred to as Executive Order 17-322.
