## STATE OF FLORIDA OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 17-33 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 16-243)

WHEREAS, the State Attorney for the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 16-243 to the Twelfth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Yvonne Gerrish for three counts of sale of controlled substance and one count of sale of counterfeit controlled substance; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable ED BRODSKY, State Attorney for the Twelfth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that Yvonne Gerrish has been arrested in a new case for possession of a controlled substance without prescription and possession of paraphernalia; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable ANDREW H. WARREN, State Attorney for the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charge and allegation in these matters; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 16-243 is hereby amended to include the additional charge of possession of a controlled substance without prescription and possession of paraphernalia.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 16-243 is ratified and reaffirmed.
