STATE OF FLORIDA OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 17-34 (DISSOLVING EXECUTIVE ORDERS 17-06 AND 17-07)

WHEREAS, Executive Order 16-291 was issued on December 23, 2016, extending the assignment of the Honorable WILLIAM EDDINS, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit, to the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit to represent the State of Florida concerning charges pending against Michael Anthony Montano under Executive Order 16-22; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 17-06 was subsequently issued in error relating to the extension already addressed in Executive Order 16-291; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 16-292 was issued on December 23, 2016, extending the assignment of the Honorable WILLIAM EDDINS, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit, to the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit to represent the State of Florida concerning charges pending against Ann Louise Gregory under Executive Order 15-13, as extended by Executive Order 16-18; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 17-07 was subsequently issued in error relating to the extension already addressed in Executive Order 16-292; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the State of Florida to dissolve Executive Orders 17-06 and 17-07, which are duplicative; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following

Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Orders 17-06 and 17-07 are hereby dissolved.
