EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 18-163

(AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 18-12, AMENDED BY EXECUTIVE ORDER 18-37)

WHEREAS, the State Attorney for the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 18-12, and amended by Executive Order 18-37, to the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Martise Terrell Pointer for petit theft second degree, a notice to appear for larceny-petit theft, and grand theft; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable MICHAEL J. SATZ, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that Martise Terrell Pointer has been arrested for possession of Fentanyl, strong arm robbery without a weapon, and criminal mischief; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable DAVID ARONBERG, State Attorney for the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charges in these matters; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 18-12, amended by Executive Order 18-37, is hereby amended to include the additional charges of possession of fentanyl, strong arm robbery without a weapon, and criminal mischief.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 18-12, amended by Executive Order 18-37, is ratified and reaffirmed.
