EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 18-164

WHEREAS, the Honorable MICHAEL J. SATZ, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was previously assigned by Executive Order 16-165, amended by Executive Order 16-179, and extended by Executive Order 17-168, to the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to represent the State of Florida concerning charges pending against Lamar Hardnette, Shakara Monik Martin, and Gabrielle Quintesha Byrd; and

WHEREAS, the Assigned State Attorney has advised the Governor that the duties required by the previous executive assignment have not yet been completed as the case involving Dale Hardnette is pending and trial is scheduled for September 17, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Assigned State Attorney has further advised the Governor that an extension of this assignment is necessary in order to complete the assigned duties; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the State of Florida and of the ends of justice that the assignment of the Assigned State Attorney be continued with respect to the above matters, pursuant to section 27.14, Florida Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue the following Executive Order:

Section 1.

Executive Order 16-165, amended by Executive Order 16-179, extended by Executive Order 17-168, is reaffirmed and the executive assignment is extended for an additional period of one (1) year, to and including July 15, 2019.

Section 2.

The Assigned State Attorney shall notify the Governor on or before June 15, 2019, if additional time is required.
