EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 18-18

WHEREAS, Shelley J. Kravitz, County Court Judge, Miami-Dade County, has passed away;
and

WHEREAS, Article X, Section 3, of the Florida Constitution, and section 114.01(1)(b), Florida Statutes, provide that a vacancy in office shall occur upon the death of an incumbent public officer;
and

WHEREAS, section 114.01(2), Florida Statutes, provides that the Governor shall file an Executive Order with the Secretary of State setting forth the facts giving rise to the vacancy in office.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, declare that due to the death of Shelley J. Kravitz, a vacancy exists in Miami-Dade County, which I shall fill in compliance with the law.
