## OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 18-193 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 18-184)

WHEREAS, the Honorable BRUCE H. COLTON, the State Attorney for the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 18-184 to the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Alan Roy Worth; and

WHEREAS, a scrivener's error occurred in that Executive Order 18-184 referenced Alan Roy Worth's employer and the Cocoa Beach Police Department; however, he is employed by the Cocoa Police Department; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

### Section 1.


Executive Order 18-184 is hereby amended to correct Alan Roy Worth's employer as the Cocoa Police Department.
