EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 18-194

(AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 18-17-152, EXTENDED BY EXECUTIVE ORDER 18-128)

WHEREAS, the Honorable WILLIAM P. CERVONE, the State Attorney for the Eighth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 17-152, and extended by 18-128, to the Fourth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Melissa D. Wilkes; and

WHEREAS, a scrivener's error occurred in that Executive Orders 17-152 and 18-128 references the defendant as Melissa D. Wilkes, however, her name is Melinda D. Wilkes; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 17-152, extended by Executive Order 18-128, is hereby amended to identify the defendant as Melinda D. Wilkes.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 17-152, and extended by Executive Order 18-128, is ratified and reaffirmed.
