WARD, State Attorney for the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit, relating to Nicholas Ferro; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable STEPHEN B. RUSSELL, was assigned to the original case for Nicholas Ferro and subsequently was assigned by Executive Order 18-115, was assigned to handle this 3.850 motion; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the State of Florida to dissolve Executive Order 18-48 as the Honorable STEPHEN B. RUSSELL is handling this motion under Executive Order 18-115;



Section 1.


Executive Order 18-48 is hereby dissolved.
