EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 18-204

WHEREAS, Jeffrey Hunter (Hunter) is presently serving as City Commissioner for the City of Deland, Florida; and

WHEREAS, on June 28, 2018, Hunter was charged by Information with Sale of a Schedule II substance, a second-degree felony in violation of section 893.13, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, section 112.51(2), Florida Statutes, provides that the Governor may suspend from office any elected municipal officer who is informed against for the commission of a state felony; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the residents of the City of Deland, and the citizens of the State of Florida, that Hunter be immediately suspended from the public office, which he now holds, upon the grounds set forth in this executive order.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, pursuant to section 112.51, Florida Statutes, find as follows:

- A. Jeffrey Hunter is, and at all times material hereto was, a City Commissioner for the City of Deland, Florida.
- B. The office of City Commissioner for the City of Deland, Florida, is within the purview of the suspension powers of the Governor, pursuant to section 112.51, Florida Statutes.
- C. On June 28, 2018, Hunter was charged by Information with Sale of a Schedule II substance, a second-degree felony in violation of section 893.13, Florida Statutes,

as evidenced by the attached Information filed in the Seventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, which is incorporated as if fully set forth in this Executive Order.

BEING FULLY ADVISED in the premises, and in accordance with the Constitution and the Laws of the State of Florida, this Executive Order is issued, effective immediately:

Section 1. Jeffrey Hunter is suspended from the public office, which he now holds, to wit: City Commissioner for the City of Deland, Florida.

Section 2. Jeffrey Hunter is prohibited from performing any official act, duty, or function of public office; from receiving any pay or allowance; and from being entitled to any of the emoluments or privileges of public office during the period of this suspension, which period shall be from today, until further Executive Order is issued, or as otherwise provided by law.

COUNT I: JEFFREY S HUNTER, on, about, and on discrete dates between May 1, 2017 and August 31, 2017, in the County of VOLUSIA and State of Florida, unlawfully and knowingly did sell, manufacture, deliver or possess with intent to sell, manufacture, or deliver a substance classified within Schedule II, Florida Statute 893.03(2), commonly known as HYDROCODONE, a controlled substance, contrary to Florida Statute 893.13(1)(a). 
