OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 18-228

WHEREAS, Executive Order 18-180 assigned the Honorable BRIAN HAAS, State Attorney for the Tenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, to the Ninth Judicial Circuit to discharge the duties of the Honorable ARAMIS D. AYALA, relating to the arrest of Rakim K. Gore for battery on a person 65 years of age or older; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable ARAMIS D. AYALA advised that a conflict existed as the defendant is related to an employee of the state attorney's office; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable ARAMIS D. AYALA, has advised that this conflict no longer exists; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the State of Florida to dissolve Executive Order 18-180.



Executive Order 18-180 is hereby dissolved.


