## OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 18-233 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 18-200)

WHEREAS, the State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 18-200 to the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Alison Lichter for violation of an injunction for protection against domestic violence; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable DAVID ARONBERG, State Attorney for the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that Alison Lichter was charged with violation of a no contact order; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable MICHAEL J. SATZ, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charge and allegation in these matters; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

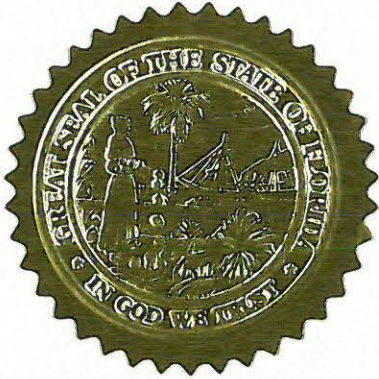
### Section 1.

Executive Order 18-200 is hereby amended to include the additional charge of violation of a no contact order.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 18-200 is ratified and reaffirmed.
