## OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 18-240 (Special Election – Municipal Service District of Ponte Vedra Beach)

WHEREAS, Chapter 2002-373, §2, Laws of Florida, provides that the Municipal Service District of Ponte Vedra Beach Board of District Trustees (“Board”) is elected; and

WHEREAS, no persons qualified to fill the offices on the Board, Seat 7, and therefore no person will be elected at the general election to fill the office; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 100.101(1), Florida Statutes, no persons will be elected to fill the office which is required to be filled by election at the general election; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 100.141(1), Florida Statutes, the Governor is required, after consulting with the Secretary of State, to issue an order declaring the dates special elections shall be held;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, as Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to take care that the laws be faithfully executed, and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby promulgate the following Executive Order, to take immediate effect:

Section 1.

A Special General Election shall be held on November 6, 2018, in St. Johns County, to fill the office on the Board.
