OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 18-274 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 18-251)

WHEREAS, the State Attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 18-251 to the First Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Whitney Brooke Miller for trespassing in a structure or conveyance while occupied by a human being (includes attempt); and

WHEREAS, the Honorable WILLIAM EDDINS, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that Whitney Brooke Miller has an additional charge of trespassing in a structure or conveyance while occupied by a human being (includes attempt); and

WHEREAS, the Honorable GLENN HESS, State Attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charge in these matters; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 18-251 is hereby amended to include the pending violation of probation.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 18-251, is ratified and reaffirmed.
