OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 18-291 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 18-259)

WHEREAS, the State Attorney for the Fourth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 18-259 to the Seventh Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Jessie James Pack, III, for simple battery, aggravated stalking, and pretrial release condition violation for domestic violence; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable R.J. LARIZZA, State Attorney for the Seventh Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that Jessie James Pack, III, has recently been arrested for violation of pretrial release conditions for domestic violence; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable MELISSA W. NELSON, State Attorney for the Fourth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charge in these matters; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 18-259 is hereby amended to include the pending violation of pretrial release conditions for domestic violence.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 18-259, is ratified and reaffirmed.
