EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 18-375

(AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 18-372)

WHEREAS, on December 19, 2018, Executive Order 18-372 was issued extending Executive Order 17-15, extended by Executive Order 18-04, assigning the Honorable PHIL ARCHER, the State Attorney for the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, to the Ninth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against David C. Buchan; and

WHEREAS, sections 1 and 2 have incorrect dates. The extension date in Section 1. should be January 25, 2020, and in Section 2. the date should be December 25, 2019; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 18-372 extending Executive Order 17-15, extended by Executive Order 18-04, is hereby amended to reflect that Executive Order 17-15, extended by Executive Order 18-04, is reaffirmed and the executive assignment is extended for an additional period of one (1) year, to and including January 25, 2020. The Assigned State Attorney shall notify the Governor on or before December 25, 2019, if additional time is required.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 17-15, extended by Executive Orders 18-27, and 18-372, is ratified and reaffirmed.
