EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 18-376

(AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 18-373)

WHEREAS, on December 19, 2018, Executive Order 18-373 was issued extending Executive Order 18-23, assigning the Honorable PHIL ARCHER, the State Attorney for the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, to the Ninth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Kiara Kanece McCree; and

WHEREAS, sections 1 and 2 have incorrect dates. The extension date in Section 1, should be January 29, 2020, and in Section 2, the date should be December 29, 2019; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 18-373 extending Executive Order 18-23, is hereby amended to reflect that Executive Order 18-23 is reaffirmed and the executive assignment is extended for an additional period of one (1) year, to and including January 29, 2020. The Assigned State Attorney shall notify the Governor on or before December 29, 2019, if additional time is required.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 18-23, extended by Executive Order 18-373, is ratified

and reaffirmed.
