## OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 18-93 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 18-56)

WHEREAS, the State Attorney for the Fourth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 18-56 to the Seventh Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against James Platt for violation of an injunction for protection and possession of drug paraphernalia; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable R.J. LARIZZA, State Attorney for the Seventh Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that James Platt has been arrested for trespassing; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable MELISSA W. NELSON, State Attorney for the Fourth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charge in these matters; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

### Section 1.

Executive Order 18-56 is hereby amended to include the additional charge of trespassing.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 18-56 is ratified and reaffirmed.
