## OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 19-114 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 18-239)

WHEREAS, the State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 18-239 to the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Alexander Michael Jude Gale; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable MICHAEL J. SATZ, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Ron DeSantis that Alexander Michael Gave a.k.a. Alexander Gale, has recently been arrested for possession of cannabis; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charge in these matters; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

### Section 1.

Executive Order 18-239 is hereby amended to include the pending charge of possession of cannabis.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 18-239, is ratified and reaffirmed.
