EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 19-173

(AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 19-123)

WHEREAS, the State Attorney for the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 19-123 to the Twefth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle allegations pending against Robert Santinello; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable ED BRODSKY, State Attorney for the Twelfth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Ron DeSantis that an additional allegation of aggravated battery of a victim 65 years or older has been made against Robert Santinello; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable ANDREW H. WARREN, State Attorney for the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional allegation in these matters; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 19-123 is hereby amended to include the pending allegation of aggravated battery of a victim 65 years or older.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 19-123, is ratified and reaffirmed.
