STATE OF FLORIDA OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 19-242 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 19-193)

WHEREAS, the State Attorney for the Second Judicial Circuit of Florida was assigned by Executive Order 19-193 to the First Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Beau James Calvin White; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable WILLIAM EDDINS, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Ron DeSantis that Beau James Calvin White has an additional charge for conditional release violation – domestic violence; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable JACK CAMPBELL, State Attorney for the Second Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charge in these matters; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 19-193 is hereby amended to include the additional charges for conditional release violation – domestic violence.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 19-193, is ratified and reaffirmed.
