EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 19-35

(AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 19-32)

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2019, Executive Order 19-32 was issued eliminating Common Core, ensuring high-quality academic standards and raising the bar for civic literacy; and

WHEREAS, a scrivener's error occurred in Executive Order 19-32 under Section 1.F. incorrectly spelling United States.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Section 1. F. is revised to read as follows:

F. identify opportunities to equip high school graduates with sufficient knowledge of America's civics, particularly the principles reflected in the United States Constitution, so as to be capable of discharging the responsibilities associated with American citizenship; and

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 19-32 is ratified and reaffirmed.
