EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 20-197

WHEREAS, Dexter Barber, a member of the Board of County Commissioners, Liberty County, has passed away; and

WHEREAS, Article X, Section 3, of the Florida Constitution, and section 114.01(1)(b), Florida Statutes, provide that a vacancy in office shall occur upon the death of an incumbent public officer; and

WHEREAS, section 114.01(2), Florida Statutes, provides that the Governor shall file an Executive Order with the Secretary of State setting forth the facts giving rise to the vacancy in office.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, declare that due to the death of Dexter Barber, a vacancy exists on the Board of County Commissioners, Liberty County, which I shall fill in compliance with the law.
