OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 20-205 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 20-13)

WHEREAS, the Honorable JACK CAMPBELL, State Attorney for the Second Judicial Circuit of Florida was assigned by Executive Order 20-13 to the First Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Robert Earl Smith; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable WILLIAM EDDINS, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit of Florida, has advised Governor Ron DeSantis that Robert Earl Smith has an additional charge of petit theft; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable JACK CAMPBELL, State Attorney for the Second Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charge of petit theft; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to “take care that the laws be faithfully executed,” and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.


Executive Order 20-13 is hereby amended to include the additional charge of petit theft.
