## OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 20-25 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 20-19)

WHEREAS, the State Attorney for the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida was assigned by Executive Order 20-19 to the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Christopher Joseph Warren; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable DAVID ARONBERG, State Attorney for the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Ron DeSantis that the defendant's name is Joseph Christopher Warren; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:


### Section 1.

Executive Order 20-19 is hereby amended to reflect the defendant's name is Joseph Christopher Warren.


### Section 2.


Except as amended herein, Executive Order 20-19 is ratified and reaffirmed.
