STATE OF FLORIDA OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 20-257 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 20-163)

WHEREAS, the Honorable BRUCE H. COLTON, State Attorney for the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida was assigned by Executive Order 20-163 to the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Alissa Thomas; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable DAVID ARONBERG, State Attorney for the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has advised Governor Ron DeSantis that allegations have been made against Alissa Thomas for simple battery; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable DAVID ARONBERG, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the allegation of simple battery; and


NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 20-163 is hereby amended to include the allegation of simple battery.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 20-163 is ratified and reaffirmed.
