OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 21-111 (State Attorney Executive Assignment)

WHEREAS, by Confidential Executive Order 20-168, the State Attorney for the Fifth Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida was assigned to the Fourth Judicial Circuit to discharge the duties of the State Attorney for the Fourth Judicial Circuit of Florida in all matters relating to the Florida Department of Law Enforcement's investigation of former Clay County Sheriff Darryl Daniels for allegations of official misconduct; and

WHEREAS, the State Attorney for the Fifth Judicial Circuit has advised the Governor that the confidentiality of Executive Order 20-168 may be removed; and

WHEREAS, under section 27.151, Florida Statutes, the Governor may make public a previously confidential executive order filed pursuant to section 27.14, Florida Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 16-168, which assigned the State Attorney for the Fifth Judicial Circuit to the Fourth Judicial Circuit to represent the State of Florida relating to the Florida Department of Law Enforcement's investigation of Darryl Daniels for allegations of official misconduct, is no longer confidential.
