EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 21-145

(Amendment of State Attorney Executive Assignment)

WHEREAS, the State Attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida was assigned by Executive Order 21-36 to the First Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle a case involving Leah Danae Smith who was arrested for possession of a controlled substance without a prescription; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable GINGER BOWDEN MADDEN, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, has advised Governor RON DESANTIS that Leah Danae Smith has also been charged with petit theft.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to “take care that the laws be faithfully executed,” and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1. Executive Order 21-36 is hereby amended to include the charge of petit theft.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Executive Order 21-36 is ratified and reaffirmed.
