EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 21-146

(Amendment of State Attorney Executive Assignment)

WHEREAS, the State Attorney for the Tenth Judicial Circuit of Florida was assigned by Executive Order 21-117 to the Ninth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle a case involving Jeremy J. Spikes who was arrested for battery; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable MONIQUE H. WORRELL, State Attorney for the Ninth Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, has advised Governor RON DESANTIS that Jeremy J. Spikes has also been arrested for criminal mischief.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to “take care that the laws be faithfully executed,” and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1. Executive Order 21-117 is hereby amended to include Jeremy J. Spikes’ arrest for criminal mischief.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Executive Order 21-117 is ratified and reaffirmed.
