OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 21-153

(Executive Order of Suspension)

WHEREAS, Article IV, Section 7(c) of Florida Constitution provides in relevant part that "[b]y order of the Governor any elected municipal officer indicted for crime may be suspended from office until acquitted"; and

WHEREAS, Kristen Tieshia Fitzgerald is presently serving as City Commissioner for the City of Lake Wales, Florida, having been elected by the voters of the City of Lake Wales for a four-year term which began on May 4, 2021; and

WHEREAS, on June 24, 2021, Kristen Tieshia Fitzgerald was charged by Information for the felony charges of interference with custody, in violation of section 787.03, Florida Statutes, and aggravated assault with a deadly weapon without intent to kill, in violation of section 784.021, Florida Statutes, for conduct on or about June 2, 2021; and

WHEREAS, violations of sections 787.03 and 784.021, Florida Statutes, constitute felonies in the third degree; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the residents of the City of Lake Wales and the citizens of the State of Florida, that Kristen Tieshia Fitzgerald be immediately suspended from the public office which she now holds, upon the grounds set forth in this executive order.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, pursuant to Article IV, Section 7(c), and section 112.51, Florida Statutes, find as follows:

A. Kristen Tieshia Fitzgerald, and at all times material hereto was, City Commissioner for the City of Lake Wales, Florida.

- B. The office of City Commissioner for Lake Wales, Florida, is within the purview of the suspension powers of the Governor, pursuant to Article IV, Section 7(c) and Chapter 112 of the Florida Statutes.
- C. The Information alleges that Kristen Tieshia Fitzgerald committed felony acts in violation of the Laws of Florida while serving as a City Commissioner. This suspension is predicated upon the attached Information which is incorporated as if fully set forth in this Executive Order.

BEING FULLY ADVISED in the premises, and in accordance with the Constitution and the Laws of the State of Florida, this Executive Order is issued, effective immediately:

Section 1. Kristen Tieshia Fitzgerald is suspended from the public office, which she now holds, to wit: City Commissioner for the City of Lake Wales, Florida.

Section 2. Kristen Tieshia Fitzgerald is prohibited from performing any official act, duty, or function of public office; from receiving any pay or allowance; and from being entitled to any of the emoluments or privileges of public office during the period of this suspension, which period shall be from today, until further Executive Order is issued, or as otherwise provided by law.
