## STATE OF FLORIDA OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 21-186 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 21-33)

WHEREAS, the State Attorney for the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida was assigned by Executive Order 21-33 to the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle the arrest of Anthony D. Jackson for multiple burglary-related charges and other charges in cases #2100067CF10A, #2101090CF10A, #21000865CF10A and #21000868CF10A; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable HAROLD F. PRYOR, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, has advised Governor RON DESANTIS that Anthony D. Jackson has been subsequently charged with multiple other offenses in cases #21003077CF10A, #21004827CF10A, and a non-in-custody case involving possession of cocaine and improper stop/stand/park.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1. Executive Order 21-33 is hereby amended to include subsequent charges in multiple offenses in cases #21003077CF10A, #21004827CF10A, and a non-in-custody case involving possession of cocaine and improper stop/stand/park.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Executive Order 21-33 is ratified and reaffirmed.
