EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 21-187

(AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 21-163)

WHEREAS, Executive Order 21-163 was issued assigning the State Attorney for the Twelfth Judicial Circuit to the Twentieth Judicial Circuit to represent the State of Florida concerning a pending violation of probation for Brent Circle; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 21-163 is amended to reflect that the assistant state attorney referenced in the conflict is from the Twentieth Judicial Circuit.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to “take care that the laws be faithfully executed,” and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 21-163 is hereby amended to reflect that the assistant state attorney referenced in Executive Order 21-163 is from the Twentieth Judicial Circuit.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 21-163 is ratified and reaffirmed.
