OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 21-188 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 20-201)

WHEREAS, the Honorable DAVID ARONBERG, State Attorney for the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida was assigned by Executive Order 20-201, as amended by Executive Order 21-76, to the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle a pending probation status hearing and a charge of aggravated battery on a person over 65 years of age or older against George Neuner; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable HAROLD F. PRYOR, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, has advised Governor RON DESANTIS that recently George Neuner has been arrested for battery on a person over 65 years of age or older and two violations of probation.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to “take care that the laws be faithfully executed,” and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 20-201, as amended by Executive Order 21-76, is hereby amended to include the additional charge of aggravated battery on a person 65 years of age or older and two violations of probation.

Section 2.


Except as amended herein, Executive Order 20-201, as amended by Executive Order 21-76 is ratified and reaffirmed.
