## **EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 21-261**

(AMENDMENT OF STATE ATTORNEY EXECUTIVE ASSIGNMENT)

WHEREAS, the Honorable DAVID ARONBERG, State Attorney for the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida was assigned by Executive Order 20-201, as amended by Executive Orders 21-76, 21-188 and 21-196, to the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to represent the State of Florida concerning charges and violations of probation pending against George Neuner; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable HAROLD F. PRYOR, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, has advised Governor RON DESANTIS that George Neuner has an additional charge of aggravated battery on a person over 65 years of age, two pending violations of probation, and a new allegation of violation of injunction of domestic violence.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1. Executive Order 20-201, as amended by Executive Orders 21-76, 21-88 and 21-196, is hereby amended to include the additional charge of aggravated battery on a person over 65 years of age, two pending violations of probation, and a new allegation of violation of injunction of domestic violence.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Executive Order 20-201, as amended by Executive Orders 21-76, 21-188 and 21-196, is ratified and reaffirmed.
