OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 21-30 (DISSOLVING EXECUTIVE ORDER 21-13)

WHEREAS, Executive Order 20-308 was issued on December 18, 2020, assigning the State Attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit to handle an executive assignment for the State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit of Florida regarding Whitney Brooke Miller; and

WHEREAS, a duplicate executive assignment of this case was made under Executive Order 21-13.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to “take care that the laws be faithfully executed,” and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 21-13 is hereby dissolved.
