EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 21-87

(Amendment of State Attorney Executive Assignment)

WHEREAS, the State Attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida was assigned by Executive Order 20-308 to the First Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle a case involving Whitney Brooke Miller who was charged with driving under the influence, a misdemeanor; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable GINGER BOWDEN MADDEN, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, has advised Governor RON DESANTIS that Whitney Brooke Miller has been additionally charged with driving under the influence with damage to property or person and reckless driving, misdemeanors.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

<u>Section 1.</u> Executive Order 20-308 is hereby amended to include the charges of driving under the influence with damage to property or person and reckless driving, misdemeanors.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Executive Order 20-308 is ratified and reaffirmed.
