Notice of Accepting Applications

Governor Scott has declared a vacancy on the Sixth Judicial Circuit, Circuit Court, brought about by the retirement of Judge W. Lowell Bray, Jr. Accordingly, the Sixth Circuit Judicial Nominating Commission is now accepting applications for this vacancy.

Qualification of Applicants:

Applicants must be able to fulfill the Constitutional qualifications before assuming the office of Circuit Court Judge, which require the person to be a member in good standing of the Florida Bar for the preceding five (5) years, a resident of the Sixth Judicial Circuit and a registered voter in the State of Florida.
