Notice of Accepting Applications

On June 13, 2013, the Supreme Court ordered the involuntary retirement of Judge David Allen Glant, creating a vacancy on the Eighth Judicial Circuit. Accordingly, the Eighth Circuit Judicial Nominating Commission is now accepting applications for this vacancy.

Qualification of Applicants:

Applicants must fulfill the Constitutional qualifications before assuming the office of Circuit Court Judge, which require the person to be a member in good standing of the Florida Bar for the preceding five years, a resident of the Eighth Judicial Circuit and a registered voter in the State of Florida. All applications and all interviews and proceedings of the Commission, except for deliberations by the Commission, shall be open to the public, as required by law.
