Applicants for this circuit judgeship must have been members of The Florida Bar for the preceding five years, must be registered to vote in the State of Florida, and must reside in Polk, Hardee or Highlands County at the time the successful applicant is sworn into office.

In addition to the original and seven copies, applicants are requested to provide one electronic unredacted (PDF) copy of the application and one electronic redacted (PDF) copy of the application. Any material redacted by the applicant must be limited to exempt or confidential information that is exempt from public inspection pursuant to Chapter 119 and Florida's public records law.
