RE: ROBERT THEODORE BURGER

On October 5, 2015, the Judicial Qualifications Commission recommended that the Court order the involuntary retirement of Eighteen Judicial Circuit Judge Robert Theodore Burger due to a permanent disability that seriously interferes with the performance of his judicial duties. Judge Burger does not contest the Commission's recommendation. Therefore, we approve the Stipulation, adopt the Commission's recommendation, and declare Judge Burger to be involuntarily retired from judicial service as of close of business at 5:00 p.m., Monday, October 12, 2015.
