Grosshans fills the vacancy created by the resignation of Judge William D. Palmer.

**Judge John M. Harris**, 51, of Mims, is a circuit judge for the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit, and previously served as county judge for Brevard County Court. He received his bachelor's degree from Oklahoma University and his law degree from Florida State University College of Law. Harris fills the vacancy created by the resignation of Judge Thomas D. Sawaya.
